After the MOU signed in 27 April 2015, and following the Protocol:

WHEREAS:

- (a) WAVE is recognized by its members as the sole international authority in what concerns working equitation and comprises the entities responsible for the organization of working equitation in different current or future country members;
- (b) WAVE is statutorily bound to pursue the recognition of working equitation as an official discipline by the International Equestrian Federation ("FEI");
- (c) WAVE recognizes the FEI as the sole and exclusive entity with the authority to regulate and organize the traditional equestrian disciplines of equitation and its corresponding competitions;



- (d) WAVE is bound to foster the development of working equitation, divulging and promoting general working equitation principles, always safeguarding the differences (type of mount, harness and dress) existing in the different countries, never preventing the entry of new countries, even those which in spite of not having a tradition of horse work in the field, wish to comply with its articles of association, general regulations and private articles;
- (e) WAVE may provisionally accept the membership of a national organization other than a national federation provided that no entity from the country in question is already a member, pursuant to which the referred organization enjoys the same rights given to a national federation within the WAVE and consequently its recognition;
- (f) **ANWE** expressly recognizes WAVE as the only international organization responsible for working equitation and further declares to accept and apply all the regulations currently in force as well as the future regulations emanated by WAVE;
- (g) WAVE acknowledges the second party's potential to foster the development and recognition of working equitation in **Australia** and wishes to provide its assistance and support to pursue such goals.

NOW therefore it is hereby agreed as follows:

#### Clause 1

WAVE appoints the second party as Official Accredited Agent for the promotion of Working Equitation in **Australia**, since **August 2016**.

#### Clause 2

As Official Accredited Agent of WAVE in **Australia**, the second party agrees to:

- (a) Organize and promote at least 2 (two) national official working equitation competitions in its country according to WAVE's practices, standards, rules and regulations, attended and verified by WAVE officials;
- (b) Unconditionally abide by and apply WAVE's general and internal regulations, refraining itself from the use of any other regulation.
- (c) Render the necessary publicity to the Regulations in force as of the date of the signature, namely publish them in the respective website;
- (d) Promote the participation of officials in the WAVE organized formation courses
- (e) Inform WAVE of the yearly activities



**Clause 3**

As Official Accredited Agent of WAVE in **Australia**, the second party is entitled to:

- (a) Use the designation of exclusive Official Accredited Agent of WAVE in **Australia** for the Effective Period;
- (b) Exclusively appoint a national team and individual competitors to attend European and World official championships organized by WAVE;
- (c) Receive WAVE's full support and assistance.

**Clause 4**

In the event of any breach by the second party to any of its obligations under this Protocol, which is not remedied within 30 days from notice given by WAVE, this Protocol may be unilaterally terminated by WAVE.
